To apply for reinstatement from resignation, when resigned for 2 years or more

Applicant may apply pursuant to Rule 64(f)(1)(B) Ariz. R. Sup. Ct. <u>meeting all the requirements</u>, or Rule 65 Ariz. R. Sup. Ct.

Rule 64(f)(1)(B): If Applicant qualifies to apply pursuant to Rule 64(f)(1)(B) Ariz. R. Sup. Ct. the process takes approximately 1-2 months but requires payment of pay back dues and fees.

CALCULATION OF BACK DUES AND FEES: It is incumbent upon Applicant to contact the State Bar of Arizona's Membership Department to inquire the total back dues and fees due when applying under Rule 64(f)(1)B Ariz. R. Sup. Ct. The e-mail is: mailto:membership@staff.azbar.org. Please indicate reinstating to active or inactive/retired status.

MCLE: For MCLE status, requirements and MCLE fees, contact the MCLE Department, at mailto:MCLE@staff.azbar.org. Include any other jurisdictions Applicant has been actively practicing in during the Suspension. <u>Please indicate if reinstating to active or inactive/retired status.</u>

Back dues and fees must be paid prior to reinstatement. There is not a mandated application form or template to apply. However, click here for an affidavit that may be used.

Upon verification of compliance, the board shall enter a letter of reinstatement.

Rule 65: If Applicant determines to apply pursuant to Rule 65 Ariz. R. Sup. Ct. the process may take approximately 6-7 months and requires a hearing in Phoenix.
