

State Bar of Arizona Member Fees Reimbursement Request

The State Bar shall conduct any activities that are necessarily or reasonably incurred for the purpose of regulating the legal profession or improving the quality of legal services available to the public in compliance with *Keller v. State Bar of California*, 496 U.S. 1 (1990). Any member who objects to particular State Bar activities may request a refund of the portion of the annual fee allocable to those activities. Rule 32, Ariz.R.Sup.Ct.

This form shall be used by a member who requests a refund based on a claim that the State Bar is funding or has funded activities in violation of Rule 32. This challenge is made to the CEO/Executive Director of the State Bar.

This form must be completed and received at the State Bar office in Phoenix, Arizona, on or before February 1 of the year immediately following the calendar year in which the challenged activity occurred. Failure to submit a written challenge by the deadline shall constitute a waiver. Submission of a challenge does not relieve a member from timely paying his or her membership fees in full.

Final determinations and reimbursements, if any, will be made by the State Bar Board of Governors upon expiration of the deadline for receipt of written challenges to the same activity.
